IV. Policy Statement

- A. Attendance is an essential job function. Unless an applicable exception applies, Smyrna School District employees must adhere to work schedules applicable to their respective positions outlined in the agreement between the Smyrna School District Board of Education and the Smyrna Educators Association.
- B. Allowable absences include state holidays as outlined in 1 Del. C. 501 and approved sick, personal, vacation, and bereavement leaves, as put forth in 14 Del. C. 1318, 1319 and 1320. Smyrna School District employees shall:
 - Maintain an acceptable attendance record by reporting to work on-time each day and remaining at work until the end of the scheduled workday.
 - 2. Follow district procedures for reporting absences, tardiness, or departures that deviate from the established schedule.
 - 3. Follow district procedure for return to work, as applicable.

C. Tardiness, unexcused absences, patterns of absenteeism (e.g. same days over a period),

fraudulent use of paid or unpaid leave, and absences in excess of leave balances (other

than FMLA, leave as a reasonable accommodation or Paid Parental Leave-approved

leave) are cause for progressive corrective actions including disciplinary action up to

and including termination.

D. The Smyrna School District has, in the past, not enforced workforce rules prohibiting

employees from going into a "deduct" state (Unpaid Leave). Effective July 1, 2023,

employees shall work as scheduled. Any employee who is in "deduct" status (not at

work and not having available leave time) will be considered neglectful of their duty,

and subject to discipline. This procedure will not apply to employees who have job-

protected leave (e.g., under FMLA or the ADA).
